

Dear Parents,

Welcome to summer St. Peter's style! We have an awesome summer planned for your children. We will do our best to make sure they have a great summer.



Here are the things you need to know:

- **Drop off and Pick up**
  - From 7:00 to 9:00 a.m., drop off your child on the North side of the Fellowship Hall through the open double doors.
  - Preschool parents, please bring your student/students through the open double door on the Northside of the Fellowship Hall, walk to Preschool, and sign them in there.
  - If you drop off or pick up your child/children between 9:00-3:00 please come through the main office.
  - Between 3:00-3:30 please pick up through the back gate. It will always be staffed when it is open.
  - If you are exiting through the back gate at any time, please make sure it is locked behind you.
- Please put sunscreen on your child before they come for the day. We will supply the sunscreen for reapplication. This requires a Medical Authorization form to be on file. We mailed this out to you if we did not have one on file for your child. Please return the form, along with the other forms that were sent, to our office before your child attends camp. If your child requires a specific sunscreen, please notify the office. Please note, do not send sunscreen in aerosol applicators. They are not allowed on campus due to allergies and asthmatic students.
- Students need to have fully enclosed shoes that are safe for running and playing. You may send shoes for water play separately.
- Clothes must be modest and comfortable.
- ***Water, snacks, and a substantial lunch are very important.***
- Our first grade students do not nap, but will have quiet story time after lunch.
- 3rd - 4th graders **will** have the opportunity to walk across the street to Dutch Bros and Jan Rau Park. A Permission Slip will be sent home.
- 5th - 8th will have walking field trips to Jan Rau Park, Dutch Bros, Sheldon Crossing, and the Bel Air and Safeway shopping centers. A Permission Slip will be sent home.
- On Fridays 4th - 8<sup>th</sup> grade students will go to Pat O'Brien Swim Center. The cost is TBD plus extra if you'd like your student/students to get a snack at the snack shack.
  - We will leave for the pool at 12:45 p.m. and we will need parents to help us transport the children to the pool. An Auto Usage form and a coverage declaration page must be on file in the front office for all drivers. Drivers are not required to stay, although you are welcome to stay. Please let Mrs. Bunting know if your child is a non-swimmer. The pool is staffed with lifeguards and members of our staff will be in the water with the children. There is only one entrance/exit, so we are able to see your child at all times. The pool is open from 1:00-4:00 p.m. At 4:00 p.m. we walk to the play structure area. We do not come back to St. Peter's. Your student/students will need to be picked up at the pool/park.
